

# Present Tense Conjugation

Do you remember the -AR verb Endings????

## -AR Endings

Yo (I)	o	Nosotros (as) (We)	amos
Tú (You)	as	Vosotros (as) (All of you)	(a)s
Usted (You formal)	a	Ustedes (All of you formal)	an
Él/Ella (He/She)	a	Ellos/Ellas (They)	an

In Spanish we also have verbs that end in -ER. These verbs get different endings:

## -ER Endings

Yo (I)	o	Nosotros (as) (We)	emos
Tú (You)	es	Vosotros (as) (All of you)	(e)s
Usted (You formal)	e	Ustedes (All of you formal)	en
Él/Ella (He/She)	e	Ellos/Ellas (They)	en

In order to conjugate a verb you follow these steps:

1. Drop the er off the verb.
2. This leaves you with the stem.
3. Add the appropriate ending:

1. comer	2. com	3. yo com	o	nosotros com	emos
		tú com	es	vosotros com	(e)s
		Ud. com	e	Uds. com	en
		él com	e	ellos com	en

## Present Tense Conjugation

*¡Vamos a practicar! – Let's practice below. First read the sentence to determine if the sentence is talking about a food or a drink. If the sentence is talking about food, then we must conjugate the verb COMER because this means TO EAT. If the sentence is talking about a drink, then we must conjugate the verb BEBER because this means to drink.*

1. Yo COMO los waffles.
2. Tú bebés el té helado.
3. Ella bebe la limonada cuando hace calor.
4. Nosotros comemos el bistec con el puré de papas para la cena.
5. Marco come las papas fritas para el almuerzo.
6. Marta y yo bebemos el chocolate caliente cuando hace frío.
7. Pedro y Berto comen los huevos fritos con el tocino para el desayuno.
