### Important notes about the days of the week:

The days of the week are not capitalized in Spanish as they are in English.  
 (Side note: this is also true of the months of the year in Spanish.)

In Spanish culture, Monday is frequently considered as the first day of the week and not Sunday as it is in our culture here in the United States.

To say "on" with a day of the week as in "On Saturday, I'm going to the basketball game," you will use the word the (el) before the day of the week: El sábado, voy al partido de baloncesto.

To say "on" with a day of the week where something happens over and over every week on that day as in, "On Saturdays, I go to basketball games," use the word the (los) before the day of the week: Los sábados, voy a los partidos de baloncesto.

### D. Important notes about the months:

1. The months of the year are not capitalized in Spanish as they are in English. (Side note: This is also true of the days of the week in Spanish.)

#### Study tip:

2. Look at the months in Spanish. Notice how they are all spelled similar and sound a bit similar to the English words (except for "enero.") This will help you memorize the months in Spanish. Words that look similar, sound similar and mean the same thing in another language are called cognates
