

ADJECTIVES MUST AGREE!

Adjectives are words that describe nouns.

In English adjectives usually come before nouns.

But, in Spanish adjectives usually come AFTER nouns:

Examples:

- the green socks = los calcetines verdes
- the red shirt = la camisa roja
- the yellow vest = el chaleco amarillo

The BIGGEST difference about adjectives in Spanish is that they must always agree in gender & number!
