Numbers 0-9

(0) cero	(1) uno	(2) dos	(3) tres	(4) cuatro
(5) cinco	(6) seis	(7) siete	(8) ocho	(9) nueve

Numbers 11-29

(11) once	(12) doce	(13) trece	(14) catorce	(15) quince
(16) dieciséis	(17) diecisiete	(18) dieciocho	(19) diecinueve	(20) veinte
(21) veintiuno	(22) veintidós	(23) veintitrés	(24) veinticuatro	(25) veinticinco

Counting By Tens

(10) diez	(20) veinte	(30) treinta	(40) cuarenta
(50) cincuenta	(60) sesenta	(70) setenta	(80) ochenta
(90) noventa	(100) cien		

To form a number past 30 you need to know 2 things:

1. All numbers 1 through 9.
2. How to count by ten's in Spanish

To form numbers above 30 all you do is add a "y" between the **ten's** and the **one's**.

For example 35 is **treinta y cinco**.

For example 47 is Cuarenta y siete.

For example 92 is noventa y dos.

For example 76 is setenta y seis.

How To Form Numbers After 100

When saying 100 exactly we say the word: **100 = cien**

When we had any number to 100 we have to say: **ciento**

To form a number form numbers above 100 it's the same as forming numbers past 30:

(100) cien(to)	(200) doscientos	(300) trescientos
(400) cuatrocientos	(500) quinientos	(600) seiscientos
(700) setecientos	(800) ochocientos	(900) novecientos
