





. Teacher Imbedded Assessments (25 %)

- Para Hacer Ahora Daily Open-Note Quizzes will be given and gone over. Self-corrected sheets will be collected at the end of the week, meaning those who are on task should receive a 100%!
- In-class group work and/or individual work may occasionally be collected & graded. Students will be notified ahead of time.
- Oral Practice: Students can earn 5 points each week for oral participation in class. This will be tracked by the teacher during opportunities in class to orally participate.

Foundational Knowledge (56 o/o)

- Examencitos or FK tests based on checkpoints covered within a unit.
