

# ¡Proyecto de los deportes!

In unit 4, you will be researching a particular Hispanic/Latino Athlete. This athlete must be from a Spanish speaking country and play a common sport (Football, Soccer, Tennis, Basketball or Hockey). You will need to give specific facts about the athlete including:

- ◇ **City of birth** – including an interesting fact about the town or country
- ◇ **Date of birth** – include an interesting fact about that year
- ◇ **Family** – parents, siblings. Who inspired them?
- ◇ **Education** – schools, colleges. Why did they go or not go to school?
- ◇ **Career** – how did they become famous? What sport do they play?
- ◇ **Important facts** – awards, recognition, major records

**Also, you will need to identify why this athlete has interested you or why you chose to research them.**

**This will all be done through Prezi.** Prezi is an online, newer version of Powerpoint. In Prezi, you can customize your presentation anyway that you would like so that you can really express your interest in your athlete.

**Keep in mind the following as this is how your project will be graded:**

\_\_\_\_ / 18 – Core information included (6 bullets listed above) is well described with minimal errors. (3 points each)

\_\_\_\_ / 12 – Core information has at least 2 slides per bullet. Information must be **cited from an approved site**. (1 point per slide)

\_\_\_\_ / 12 – Citations are included on the provided sheet. 2 citations per bullet. Citations may only be used 1 time! (1 point per citation)

## Why is this athlete important to you?

You will use a camera or Ipad that will be provided to you to do a “monologue” answering the question “Why is this athlete important to you?” A monologue is a presentation of your ideas. In the video you will speak about this athlete’s importance to you. You will also show pictures of the athlete or sport that they play to help the viewers better understand why you chose this athlete.

You will be graded on the following:

- ❖ Video length – at least 2 minutes of your voice must be recorded in the video.
- ❖ Photos – a minimum of 5 pictures with a verbal description must be included in the video
- ❖ Script – a script must be written prior to recording
- ❖ Video Title – a creative title must be included and it may not be the title of this project or video section of the project.

The points for the video portion will be as follows:

\_\_\_ / 10 – Video Length ( 5 points per minute)

\_\_\_ / 10 – Photos with Description (2 points per picture/description)

\_\_\_ / 15 – Written Script

\_\_\_ / 10 – Preparedness (maximum of 3 note cards may be used)

\_\_\_ / 3 – Creative Title

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
